## **OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT REQUEST 2022/03**

On 11/02/22 you made a request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the OIA) for the following information:

How do I find out what was paid to Stuart Nash leading up to the 2017 election from



Following a general election or by-election, all electorate candidates are required to file a return of their candidate donations and expenses. Stuart Nash's return is attached for your review.

By way of general information, electorate candidates must keep a record of all donations received, and declare any donations over \$1500 in their return. You can find all of the candidate returns for the 2017 general election here: <a href="Candidate expenses">Candidate expenses and donations for the 2017 General Election</a>

In the interests of transparency, we release responses to Official Information Act requests every 3 months. We will publish this response with your personal details redacted.

You have the right under section 28(3) of the Act to make a complaint to the Ombudsman if you are not satisfied with the response to your request.
