OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT REQUEST 2022/81

Thank you for your request of Thursday, 19 October 2023 under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) regarding a breakdown of results on Election Day. Specifically, you have asked for:

I am requesting, under the Official Information Act, an breakdown showing all candidates' voting results on Election Day (24/10/23), percentage and number differences between party and increased and decreased of results compared with all previous elections on each electorate area (even where boundaries gave changed) back to the beginning of MMP election.

This information you have requested is publicly available. On this basis your request is refused under 18(d) of the Act.
